List September 9, 1756:

Mentions a great number of horses and cattle received at Coar Banks and Hunting Quarters Banks. Also Sedar Banks. Some delivered by James Nelson, some by Jos Welles, some by Bob Wallis. "An account of Jame Kings that was forgot the first time".

Elizabeth Wallis appears to have purchased 123 1/2 lbs of Myrtle Wax, 11 1/4 lbs of

Bees Wax, 3 Barrels of Tallow, and 13 horses Mairs [sic]. February Court 1753.
